Gator Harley-Davidson Vendor Rules & Regulations

Please read carefully and initial that you have read and agree to abide by all Rules & Responsibilities

*A letter will be emailed to you when you will be able to set up. Your display must be set up and all vehicles must be out of the vending area by 8am each morning

*All vendors must check in at the "check in tent" prior to setting up to receive your vendor packet. All monies, insurance and completely filled out application MUST be on file prior to setting up.

*Vendor displays must stay within designated square footage of space requested. This includes display racks, tables, awnings, trailer tongue, tie downs, etc. If you need additional space in front or behind your space for display racks please add footage to your size request. You may be charged for any extra footage outside of your designated space. ***Please talk to Jan about needing more space before you set up.***

- *Two (2) badges with your business name & booth number will be provided to each vendor.
- *Selling of unauthorized Harley-Davidson product or items in direct competition is STRICTLY prohibited.
- *No Merchandise considered obscene or drug paraphernalia will be allowed.
- *No vendor may assign, sublet or apportion all or any part of the privileges or of the space assigned to them, nor permit any other party to exhibit herein, other than the business to which the space is assigned and insured.
- ***All vendors must leave location clean of trash, zip ties and debris.** Each location will be inspected and noted of the condition your space was left in. **Photos and a \$100.00 invoice will be sent to you if area not clear of debris.**
- ***Absolutely NO tent stakes allowed anywhere** (streets, pavements or grass) Please instruct your tent rental company of this important rule.
- *If you hire an outside tent company to set up your tent, they must contact Jan Wideman, 352-267-3190 for setup and breakdown instructions.
- *We **do not** offer exclusive merchandise category.
- *Electricity is available within 125ft of all locations. You need to have a heavy duty extension cord at least 125ft
- ***Any tent over 144 sq.ft. shall be flame retardant. All vendors must have in their tent at lease (1) 3A-40B:C fire extinguisher with a current inspection tag and a "No Smoking" sign(s) displayed. Any tent over 400sf is required to have (2) 3A40BC fire extinguisher with a current inspection tag. The Fire Chief will be around to check each tent on Thursday.**
- *You are solely responsible for obtaining all state required licenses and permits necessary to operate your business at the Leesburg Bikefest.
- *No water, food or beverages will be allowed to be sold from your booth. This also includes giving it away as a promotional tool.
- *Vendors will be responsible for any damage that may occur to any other vendor or property due to their negligence.
- *Merchandise displaying any wording reference to Leesburg Bikefest™ or Leesburg Bikefest 2023™. The Leesburg Partnership, Inc reserves the exclusive right to the sales of Leesburg Bikefest t-shirts, patches, pins and novelties.
- ***No wording of Official Event Merchandise will be allowed on any signage. Leesburg Partnership, Inc. reserves all rights to any and all Official Event Merchandise.**
- *Violation of the above polices may result in the immediate ejection from the event and loss of booth fee. viewed. Towing will be owner's expense if we cannot reach you to move your vehicle.
- *Event is rain or shine. No refunds once your location has been assigned.
- *Gator Harley-Davidson dealership is not a bank and will not make change for you. Please come prepared. There is an ATM machine on the inside of the dealership.

Vendor Parking

- *Vendors must park in the designated area. Info will be located in the vendor packet. Vendor parking pass must be displayed on the driver's side of the windshield. Gator Harley-Davidson is not responsible for towed vehicles outside of designated areas and for improper display of parking pass.
- *Storage trailers, and RV's are not allowed to be parked behind booths (unless approved by the Event Manager)and must park in designated areas only.
